What the FAQ?

How do I create a new page? [edit] For creating a new article see Wikipedia:Your first article and Wikipedia:Article development. You need to have a Wikipedia account to create a new article. For Shortcut: creating a new page in your userspace see How do I create a user subpage? WP:FAQ#CREATE Why has my article been deleted? [edit] The best way to find out is to look at the deletion log for reasons (type the exact name of the article in the Title box, including the capitalization you used). For more Shortcut: information, see: Why was my article deleted? WP:FAQ#DELETE How do I change the name of an article? [edit] You move the article using the "move" button (to the right of the "edit this page" button). You must have an account, and it must be at least four days old and made ten Shortcut: edits to move pages. If the move is controversial or fails with an error message, visit Wikipedia:Requested moves. WP:FAQ#NAME How do I change/delete my username? [edit] For changing your username see Wikipedia: Changing username. Shortcut: For deleting your username, the truth is, you cannot; if you could delete your username, we could not attribute all of those edits you have made. You can, however, WP:FAQ#CHANGE change your username, and request that your userpage and talk page be deleted by placing {{db-user}} on both pages. How do I cite Wikipedia? [edit] See Wikipedia: Citing Wikipedia. Shortcut: When was Wikipedia last published? WP:FAQ#CITE [edit] Wikipedia is not a printed encyclopedia. If you are asking this question because you wanted to cite a certain revision of Wikipedia articles, you can see Wikipedia:Citing Shortcut: Wikipedia. WP:FAQ#PUB Who wrote article X on Wikipedia? [edit]
